| Enrollment Fee | An enrollment fee of \$150 is required for each student and is non-refundable. This fee is submitted with the student's application for enrollment. |
| Assessment Fee | An assessment fee of \$50 is required for each new student entering Kindergarten and above. The assessment will determine if the student is a candidate for Cornerstone Academy. The fee is submitted to the office on the day of the assessment and is non-refundable. |
| Supply Fee | The supply fee listed above, is required for each student, and is nonrefundable after the first day of school. The fee for the 1 st child is due on June 1 st . The supply fee for additional children may be paid June 1 st OR rolled into the total tuition balance and paid through FACTS in monthly payments. |
| Building Fee | Each family is required to pay a building fee to help with maintainance of the faciliy. Beginning school is \$150, Grammar & Secondary is \$400 per family, Selections is \$200 per family. Fees are determined by the oldest child enrolled. Due June 1 st . |
| CAPT Fee | Each family is required to pay a one time \$30 contribution to the parent group, CAPT. Due June 1 st . |
| Sibling Discount | Tuition discounts are listed above for families with more than one child enrolled at Cornerstone Academy. The oldest child pays full tuition as the 1 st child. If a family has more than 4 children, the additional children are free. |
| Pre-Payment Discount | A 2% discount is offered on tuition only, provided that all tuition and fees (application, assessment & supply) are paid in full by July 1 st . |

Class Descriptions

Preschool

T/Th or T/W/Th or M-F

8:00-4:00 (Full Day)

This class is for children who are three years old by September 1. Learning centers around five themes that evoke curiosity to explore learning. Children get to create, chant, memorize bible verses and begin the foundational skills of phonics and number sense. Students who attend Cornerstone's preschool learn 20 bible verses, all the sounds for each letter, and have the opportunity to begin writing and doing simple math. Full day kids get to have lunch and recess then an enrichment class such as music, dramatic play, science and more! You can create a custom schedule for a few short and a few long days to best fit your family's need.

PreKindergarten

Four year olds will love being in our active learning PreK class. Students are challenged with mastering letters, shapes, colors as well as letter sounds and pre-reading skills. Students are immersed in phonics and language learning centers as well as math manipulative stations. Students attend a field trip once per unit. Extended day kids get to have lunch and recess, then an enrichment class such as music, dramatic play, science and more! Kindergarten

Students go around the world to learn about all of the amazing continents. They do this by reading, writing, singing, drawing and creating while experiencing each integrated theme. By the end of Kindergarten, students will be able to write and present a report on one continent, along with reciting 26 A to Z bible verses. Because Cornerstone believes strongly in making learning interesting and engaging, the cost of 10 thematically integrated field trips is included as part of the Kindergarten adventure!

K - 12th Signature Classes

Students are engaged in a chronologically integrated study through history. They learn through songs, chants and memorization of relevant facts in every subject including grammar, spelling, world language, history and science. Students are grouped by ability for reading, spelling and math. At the conclusion of the year, students will create a Capstone Project highlighting their learning during the year. Included in tuition are 10 thematically integrated field trips. Students will also participate in events like Spelling Bee, Speech Meet, Science Fair, Capstone Projects, and musical productions.
